Jabberwock Program Engages female youth between the ages of 13-18 in a nine month enrichment program designed to promote academic excellence, community service, and cultural enrichment.

Reading Is Fundamental (RIF) Promotes reading and literacy among children and youth and encourages parental participation in learning.

Strengthening Our Leaders (SOL) Provides educationally enriching opportunities for youth, ages 6-14, with existing Standards of Learning Programs.

Elder Action Serves as an advocate and conducts service for the elderly population, especially the African American community in Northern Virginia.
